The Commissioners and staff will be in attendance at a software training session on the above date. Under Arizona law, all meetings of a public body shall be public, and all persons desiring to attend shall be permitted to attend and listen to the deliberations and proceedings. [A.R.S. § 38-431.01\(A\)](#). A meeting is defined as “the gathering, in person or through technological devices, of a quorum of the members of a public body at which they discuss, propose or take legal action, including any deliberations by a quorum with respect to that action.” [A.R.S. § 38-431\(4\)](#). “Legal action” means a collective decision, commitment or promise made by a public body pursuant to the constitution, the public body's charter, bylaws or specified scope of appointment and the laws of this state. A.R.S. § 38-431(3). The Commissioners will not engage in any discussions, deliberations, considerations, or consultations regarding matters that may foreseeably require final action or a final decision by the Commission or that may otherwise constitute a legal action. As the Commissioners will be receiving training concerning how to use a software tool, the session will not be open to the public and there is no agenda for the meeting.
